PRIVACY NOTICE FOR COVID-19

Last updated - 2 June 2021

This Privacy Notice explains how and why the Confédération Européenne de Pétanque (CEP) collects and processes your personal data in relation to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic.

1. Updates to processing activities at CEP championships and events

In order for CEP championships, events and activities (“CEP Events”) to be held the CEP must adapt its delivery strategy to protect all participants and the wider public from exposure to COVID-19.

If you choose to attend a CEP Event, we will ask you for specific personal data that you would not normally supply and have not previously supplied to the CEP. The provision of this information will help us manage the prevention of COVID-19 at CEP Events and so support a return to competitive pétanque.

The information that we will process about you in response to COVID-19 will be no more than is necessary to determine whether you may have been exposed to or may be suffering from COVID-19.

2. The types of personal data that we may process

A. Pre-event

Prior to your participation in a CEP Event, you will be required to complete the Self-Declaration form (“Self-Declaration”) for each event, which requires you to agree to the Declaration and to the CEP Return to Championship Protocols. You will not be permitted to enter the CEP Event site until you have completed the Self-Declaration. The Self-Declaration will be sent to your federation via email as an interactive PDF. Players will be responsible for providing their support team (coach, Head of Delegation) with the completed form. All other participants (Championship Staff, Officials) will receive the document from the CEP or Championship Organiser. The Self-Declaration will capture the following information:

- a) your full name;
- b) your affiliation to pétanque (player, coach, championship staff, officials etc);
- c) your email address and telephone number;
- d) the championship you are taking part in.

B. On-site

At each CEP Event that you attend, you will be required to complete the Self-Declaration and show the confirmation email to the COVID-19 Officer on the first day you access the venue.

You will also be required to verbally answer the daily Screening Questionnaire and undergo a daily temperature reading using a non-contact infrared thermometer.

C. Post Event

You will be required to report to the CEP (at covid19@cep-petanque.com) if you contract COVID-19 symptoms or a positive COVID-19 test within 14 days of leaving a CEP Event.

3. Lawful basis for processing your personal data

The COVID-19 pandemic has created a global public health crisis in which the sport of pétanque has been significantly impacted. However, given the interactive nature of pétanque, the sport cannot resume unless appropriate health checks are in place to mitigate the risk of the spread of COVID-19 and to protect the health and safety of pétanque participants.

Legitimate Interest (see GDPR Article 6(1)(f)): We consider that it is necessary to process your personal data in order for pétanque to resume and for the CEP to resume carrying on its primary business functions.

Such processing is in our legitimate interest and the interests of our pétanque partners and all stakeholders in the pétanque industry.

Public Health (see GDPR, Article 9(2)(i)): Moreover, processing your special category data at CEP Events is in the public interest for reasons of public health. CEP Events are by their nature, international. The CEP considers it is necessary to collect your personal data to protect against domestic and cross-border threats to public health.

4. How we will collect your personal data

Your personal data will be collected (i) when you complete the Self-Declaration form; and (ii) on-site at a CEP Event. On-site: Your daily temperature reading shall be taken by the CEP Event's designated COVID-19 Officer or his/her designee.

For all CEP Events, your details will be checked against our Self-Declaration Covid-19 database on the first day you enter the venue and we will ask you to answer verbally daily to the Screening Questionnaire and submit to a body temperature reading each day that you attend and participate in the CEP Event.

5. Who we may share your personal data with

While you are a participant in a CEP event, your personal data will be collected by the designated COVID-19 Officer and will be transferred to the CEP at the conclusion of the CEP event. Your personal data shall be stored in CEP's secure database hosted in our Dropbox account.

The CEP may share your personal data with other pétanque governing bodies inside and outside the European Economic Area (including without limitation: the FIPJP). The CEP may also share your personal data with the organisers of other CEP events and local government / health authorities.

The CEP will only share your personal data with these third parties if the CEP has reason to believe that you risk exposing or have exposed individuals in the pétanque (or local) community to COVID-19.

If the CEP becomes aware that you may have been exposed to COVID-19 at a CEP Event, the CEP may use your personal data for contact tracing purposes, e.g. to contact you and advise you to seek medical assessment.

Where your personal data is transferred outside the EEA, appropriate safeguards will be imposed so that your personal data is properly protected.

6. How long we may keep your personal data

The CEP will only keep your personal data for as long as is necessary to manage the risk of COVID- 19 at CEP Events, and in any event no longer than sixty (60) days.

7. Your Rights

You have a number of rights in relation to your personal data. Please refer to Chapter 3 of the GDPR for more information. If you have any concerns about how we handle your personal data in respect of COVID- 19 you may contact us at covid19@cep-petanque.com.

The CEP will keep its processing activities for the purposes of COVID-19 under constant review and will update this Privacy Notice accordingly.
