DAILY SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE

Note: this protocol is subject to change, without notice. last updated - 6 May 2021

Precautions must be taken to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 at CEP Championships. One element of this is to check whether participants have any of the main COVID-19 symptoms. All participants should have their temperature checked using an infra-red thermometer, and be asked the questions below on a daily basis prior to entering the Championship venue.

THE QUESTIONS BELOW MUST BE ANSWERED VERBALLY BY ALL PARTICIPANTS DAILY

*Close contact refers to: face to face contact (under 1 metre) for any length of time: within 1 to 2 metres for more than 15 minutes; sharing an enclosed space for more than 2 hours; living in the same household or household-like setting (e.g. hotel room, apartment or hostel).

Only those participants who have a measured temperature of below 38°C and who answer 'no' to ALL of the self- declaration questions are permitted on-site. Any participant who has a measured temperature of 38°C or answers 'yes' to any of the questions must not be permitted on-site.

Records of self-declarations and temperature screens (under or over the threshold) will be retained by the CEP for record-keeping purposes, and shared with championship staff for managing access to the championship site during the championship period only and otherwise as required by law.

Records will be kept securely and retained only for as long as is necessary for the CEP to manage the risk of COVID-19 at the Championship.
